

Activity sheet: CIDA Scavenger Hunt

1. What do the letters CIDA stand for?
2. Find on the home page CIDA's main goal. Write it down.
3. Go to the top of the home page and click on *Regions and Countries*. What would you do click next to find out about CIDA's involvement in Mozambique?
4. Once you have found the right map, click on *Mozambique*. Once on that page, list the four areas of focus for Canadian support in Mozambique.
5. From the same page about Mozambique, write your own short captions for the 2 pictures.
6. (same page) How much money CIDA contributed to Mozambique projects in 2003-2004?
7. (same page) Thanks to CIDA's contribution, how many primary school teachers have increased their skills?
8. (same page) For children at risk of measles and polio, how many doses of vaccines have been given?
9. On the left side of the page, click on *Stories from the Field*, and then click on *Bednets taunt the deadly malaria mosquito*. Answer the following 2 questions:
 - a. "How many Mozambican children die every year from malaria?"
 - b. "By what percent is malaria reduced when insecticide treated bed-nets provided by CIDA are used?"
10. Go back to the *home* page. At the top of the page, on the right, click on *Youth and Teachers*. Once on that page, go to *CIDA's Youth Zone*. Click on *Get Involved*. Find three ways you could get involved.
11. On the left side of the page, click on *Cool Sites*. Explore two of the sites listed and write their names.
12. Go back to the *Youth Zone*. On the left, click on *Photo Gallery*, and then go to Amy Brathwaite's *My Photo Gallery*. Have a look at all the pictures and name the 4 countries where they were taken.
13. Add 2 more items to the CIDA scavenger hunt list. One must be related to Mozambique and the other is your own choice. Once you are ready, ask another team to find the answers.
